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講義概要 / Course description	<p><b>Purpose:</b> This is relatively demanding course. In essence it is designed to help students understand the rough outline of U.S. history. The students are expected to regularly attend the class (and write response sheet – what interests / surprises / confuses you with why), to participate in class/web activities, and take mid-term and final examinations.</p> <p><b>Evaluation:</b> The students will be evaluated on response sheet (20%), presentations/moodle (30%), mid-term exam (25%) and final exam (25%). Those who are absent for more than 6 times will not get credit. (Please turn off your cell, refrain from talking/eating, and absolutely NO plagiarism whatsoever).</p> <p><b>Assignment:</b> (1) Presentation: In order to develop a continental perspective, students will be asked to compare/contrast historical development of U.S., Canada and Latin American countries. They are expected to orally present their cases</p>
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	and write them in the Moodle. Password will be given during the first week of instruction. (2) Examinations: ID (identification), Essay, and possibly drawing some maps.
