講義概要 / Course description	<p>Many claim that they hate history because it is boring subject. It might have lot to do with the memorization of facts seemingly unrelated to their daily lives. Yet, should historical inquiry be so all of the time? My answer is no. Particularly since this is an election year in the United States, many issues have been discussed in historical term: "Tea Party" in relation with American Revolution & Independence or "Big Government" with the Civil War & New Deal. Instead of chronologically narrate historical facts and ask you to swallow them, this course will present contrasting interpretations on selected events and have class discussions on them. In addition, the students will be asked both to draw some maps so as to understand the spatial dimension of US development and to critically evaluate historical websites which is now the largest repository of primary sources in the world. At the end, they will integrate all of the acquired information in "take home" final examination. It is a hope that such activities will make historical inquiry not only more exciting but relevant for the students who now live in fast-changing and complicated world.</p>
